


















ONCO 2026 ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

What Can be Submitted?

Types of work:

- Original research
- Case series
- Retrospective or prospective data



Abstract Formatting Guidelines

- Use the **provided template**.
- Format as follows:
 - o **Title:** Bold, sentence case
 - Author List: All authors
 - Affiliations: Institutional affiliations of all authors
 - Abstract Body: Maximum 400 words
- Structured abstract sections:
 - Introduction
 - Methods
 - o Results
 - Conclusions
- Figures/Charts: One figure or chart allowed (optional)

- Multiple submissions allowed for poster presentations.
- Registration and in-person attendance are mandatory for oral presenters.
- Attach abstract as a Word file (1 page; 2 pages if including a figure/chart).
- Indicate if you do not wish your abstract to be published in JCOP-Supplement for ONCO-26.

 - Abstracts not selected for oral presentation will automatically be moved to poster presentations.
